AFC-R EMERGENCY CLOSINGS (Cf. JGFA & JGFC)

AFC-R

The board hereby delegates to the superintendent or his/her designee, the authority to close any school whenever any condition exists which, in the opinion of the superintendent or designee, warrants the closing of one or more or all schools. In the event of unavailability, the board delegates such authority to the first available administrator in the following chain of command: assistant superintendent, building principal and director of special education. Closing of school by such an administrator shall be effective until he/she reopens the school or until the superintendent or the board reviews and takes action on the situation. In any case of extreme emergency, the principal of any school may close such school. All school closings shall be immediately reported to the superintendent and the president of the board.
