## **Enrollment Time For New Preschool and Kindergarten Students**

Students who have **NEVER** attended Beloit Elementary School, are not currently enrolled in Preschool, and are planning to attend either preschool or kindergarten next year, should plan on attending the enrollment day on Wednesday, March 29th, from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the multi-purpose room.

Parents may start to pick up pre-enrollment packets on **Wednesday, March 8th at 7:30 a.m.** The packets will not be ready before then.

When you pick up your packet, you will also sign up for a time to return the information on Wednesday, March 29th.

If you know of any parents having children ready to start school, who will not get this newsletter, please pass this information on to them.

### **VERY IMPORTANT:**

All packets are numbered. The lower number on your packet the better chance of your child being placed in the preschool session of your choice. Classes will be divided equally with boys and girls, morning and afternoon, so there are no guarantees for a particular session.

There are two sessions to choose from: 5 days a week morning or 5 days a week afternoon preschool. Please rank these choices.

The office will be open at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, March 11th for those who feel they must have a certain session. **No packets will be given out before March 8th at 7:30 a.m.** Children in our present preschool will have first priority for morning or afternoon classes if they are repeating that grade.

## Dental Screening reminder for March 9th.

Oral health screenings at your child's school for all students enrolled in grades Pre-school through 12<sup>th</sup>. In compliance with Kansas State Statute 72-5201, Kansas schools are required by law to provide oral screening for students, just like hearing and vision screenings.

In addition to the oral health screenings, **fluoride varnish applications will also be available and offered at no charge.** The application of fluoride directly to the tooth surface is effective in strengthening tooth enamel and preventing cavities. The varnish is applied immediately after the screening and it takes less than 1 minute.
