The WKOF is a "mass festival" where over 600 string players are divided into four orchestras. The four orchestras rehearse Friday afternoon and evening, Saturday morning and afternoon. The festival will conclude with a free concert at the Hays High School Gym. The concert will begin at 6:00 PM this year.. Member schools of the Western Kansas Orchestra Festival Association are Dodge City, Garden City, Hays, Hutchinson, McPherson, Salina South, Salina Central, Great Bend, and Beloit. The festival is hosted in a different location each year. Fort Hays State University and Mr. Harbaugh provides management for the festival.

Our guest clinician/conductors this year will be Rachel Dirks, Kansas State University; Lynitta Harris, Wichita; Kevin Monroe, Eldorado High School; and Shelly Wolf New, Boyd High School, McKinney Texas.

High School Orchestra audition procedure

WKOF Audition excerpts will not be selected or mailed out in advance for WKOF 2018. *Each judge will decide what excerpt from the WKOF literature will be used for the audition immediately before the auditions begin*. WKOF literature audition material will be posted outside the room before auditions begin. High School auditions will also include 1 of the 3 excerpts, 1 of the 2 scales from the KMEA All-State Audition Material, and one example from the WKOF performance selections. Excerpt and scale are to be selected will be announced in early November. The local festival manager will choose the excerpt and scale to be used. These excerpts and scales are selected on a rotating basis and will be posted on the KMEA web site very soon. Auditions will be done on a pull out basis during the first rehearsal.
