

"NO individual (student, director, parent, relative, friend, etc.) shall negatively confront an adjudicator during a music festival. An infraction by a **student performer** will result in disqualification and loss of awards and ratings received. An infraction by a **director or observer** shall result in a letter of **reprimand** sent to the school's administrator by the KSHSAA. Further action may be taken by the KSHSAA Executive Board." (2008-2009 KSHAA Music Manual) If a director is upset at an adjudicator or some aspect of the Festival, he/she is encouraged to pick up an Unpleasant Situation Form in the Festival Office and fill it out and return it to KSHSAA.

#### **TOBACCO**

There are no areas within the school building or on school property where tobacco use of any kind will be permitted. This is school policy and will be enforced.

#### PHOTOGRAPHY, VIDEO AND AUDIO RECORDING

NO photography will be allowed in performance rooms during the festival. No commercial recordings of any kind, audio and/or video, will be allowed in performance rooms during festivals. Personal recordings, audio and/or video, will be allowed in SOLO performance rooms as long as they are not a distraction to the performers or the adjudicator. Festival managers and the KSHSAA will NOT listen to or view tapes in disputes over a judge's ratings. Please make your students' relatives and friends aware of this policy.

#### HOMEROOMS, WARM-UP ROOMS, DRESSING ROOMS

The lower gymnasium will be used as homerooms. Take equipment and personal effects into the gym. Please see that cases and equipment are carried, not slid or pulled along the floor. Arrange to have an adult sponsor supervise students and equipment in this area at all times. Students are asked to stay off the lower gym floor as much as possible. NO DRINKS OR FOOD ARE ALLOWED IN THE GYMS. At the end of your stay, please leave your homeroom area neat and clean. NO BALL-PLAYING OR FRISBEE IS ALLOWED IN THE GYMS! Items will be confiscated and taken to the office where the director may pick them up. This is for student and equipment safety and for our liability.

LOCKER ROOMS ARE AVAILABLE FOR CHANGING. These are located at the south end of the gymnasium area. Two men's locker rooms are located downstairs. One women's locker room is located downstairs, and one is located upstairs. DO NOT USE THE RESTROOMS FOR DRESSING ROOMS.

#### WARM-UP ROOMS

There are nine warm-up rooms available for use. Pianos will be available in most of the rooms. Schools are encouraged to bring their own portable keyboards to use in the gyms. Please bring an extension chord if you choose to bring a piano. No cases or equipment should be left in the warm-up rooms or performance rooms. Warm-up room use will be monitored. Please provide supervision when your students are using these rooms. Schools and students will be held responsible for any damages. Please limit warm up time to ten minutes. The monitor will inform you when your time is up if there are others waiting. If your performance time is in the afternoon, please do not use the warm up areas until then. Warm-up rooms are in the north end of the east corridor of the high school area. The room numbers are: 108, 109, 110, 111, 113, 114, 115, 116, 117.

This year we will be allowing larger ensembles to warm up in our upper gym area..
