Follow these important steps on your way to becoming a Wildcatl If you have not visited K-State and would like to set up a personal visit, please call our campus visit office at 785-532-1521 at least two weeks prior to the desired date of your visit. 	Apply for Admissions at <u>k-state.edu/admissions/apply</u> . You can apply the summer after your junior year or ASAP during your senior year. o The combined application for admission and scholarships will ask for your personal information and desired major. Please provide:
	☐ Your self-reported high school courses and grades (using your course information or transcript
	as a guide) □ Self-report your official ACT or SAT scores (if you have not already sent official scores) □ Your leadership roles and activities □ A \$40 application fee
	Apply for Scholarships. The scholarship application can be completed at the same time you submit your application for admission or it can be found online at kscholarships PRIORITY DEADLINE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS IS NOVEMBER 1 OF YOUR SENIOR YEAR.
	Take the ACT/SAT (if you have not already). Register for the ACT at <u>ACT.orq</u> or SAT at <u>SAT.orq</u> . Test dates and locations can also be found on these sites. Be sure to have your official scores sent directly to K-State for each test. The K-State ACT code is: 1428. The K-State SAT code is: 6334.
	Create and remember your K-State elD. If you did not create an elD when you applied for admission, go to eid.k-state.edu to set one up. You will need your Wildcat ID (WID) number, which was listed in your Admission packet. If you did set up your elD when you applied, it will also be listed in your Admission packet. Your elD will be used to access your email and student information. Never share your password via email or with others. No one at K-State will ever ask you for your elD password.

Ontobor	Complete your residence hall application. Apply online at <u>k-state.edu/admissions/living</u> . There is a \$30 application fee (separate from your Admissions application fee). You must be admitted to K-State in order to complete the residence hall application.

	Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u> , as early as October 1. See the December section for instructions on how to apply for the FAFSA online. PRIORITY DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATION IS DECEMBER 1 OF YOUR SENIOR YEAR.
	Some independent student organizations, such as fraternities and sororities, have membership application processes and deadlines in the summer and fall.

	Complete your housing contract and roommate profile. If you have completed a residence hall application, the residence hall contract will be available in your Housing and Dining Services Resident Portal beginning Nov. 1. Complete the contract and submit the \$400 initial down payment as soon as possible to reserve your space in a residence hall. The contract completion date determines your room selection time, which is assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. For additional info, contact Housing and Dining Services at 1-888-568 5027 or housing@k-state.edu . The initial down payment is applied to your housing charges and is refundable in full until June 1.

November 1 - Priority deadline to submit the K-State scholarship application

November 3 – K-State Senior Day for Northeast Kansas – k-state.edu/admissions/seniors

November 10 - K-State Senior Day for Western and Central Kansas - k-state.edu/admissions/seniors

December

December 1 - Submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u>. When applying online, you will need to create an FSA ID. The K-State Federal Code is **001928**. If you have questions, contact your high school counselor or the K-State Office of Student Financial Assistance.

<u>February</u>

February 1 – College and departmental scholarship deadline (If you already filled out the K-State scholarship application, it will automatically be forwarded onto the academic college/department you listed on your Admissions application.)

February 1 – Selective admissions deadline for the College of Architecture, Planning, and Design; Interior Design (College of Human Ecology); College of Engineering; and Wildlife and Outdoor Enterprise Management (College of Agriculture).

The Office of Student Financial Assistance will begin mailing Student Financial Award letters to those who met the December 1 deadline. Award letters will be mailed at a later date for those who did not meet the priority deadline. Remember to accept or decline awards in your student account in KSIS. ksis.k-state.edu
