

CA GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The purpose of school administration is to help create and to foster an environment supportive of the districts' Mission Statement. All administrative duties and functions should be appraised in terms of the contribution that is made to support the adopted mission of USD No. 273. One of the most important responsibilities that rests upon the administration is to select teachers who will discover and develop in students abilities which might otherwise remain dormant.

The superintendent must shoulder most of the responsibility for the success or failure of his/her organization. He/she should possess those qualities of leadership which motivate all members of his/her staff to work for the improvement of the educational program. It is his/her responsibility, under the direction of the school board, to mobilize and coordinate all available resources in the development of an educational program designed to implement the districts' adopted mission.
