It shall be the policy of the board to encourage regular attendance at school by all students. Regular attendance contributes not only to the probability of scholastic success but also to the development of attitudes of consistent performance which will carry over into adult life.

The principal of each school is delegated the responsibility for maintaining attendance records and compiling annual attendance reports. Any student who is absent for more than three consecutive days will be reported to the parent, in writing by the principal, in the event that the principal is unable to ascertain the reason for absence. Students who have an unsatisfactory attendance record in the judgment of the principal, will be referred to the counselor or a conference with the parents will be scheduled in order to ascertain the basic cause of the attendance problem and identify possible ways in which to improve attendance.

Realizing that it may serve a student's best interests to attend another school in the Beloit area while regularly enrolled in the district, the board deems it necessary to establish certain guidelines to insure a satisfactory relationship among all concerned.

Students desiring to attend classes in other schools during the regular school day must notify their principal well in advance of their enrollment. This request should be made only after the student has received parental consent.

Transportation to and from the other school shall be the responsibility of the students and their parents. Likewise, it shall be the student's responsibility to attend all classes punctually and regularly.

Anytime during the first ten school days a student may withdraw from classes in the outside school and re-enroll in suitable classes in district schools. After this time, if the student discontinues attendance in outside school for any reason, he/she will re-enroll in district replacement classes.
