The use of probation is authorized when the achievement of discipline will be better served. Any punishment, suspension or expulsion may be deferred by the person having authority to impose same, and the student involved may be placed on probation for a fixed period of time. Said punishment, suspension or expulsion shall remain deferred so long as the conditions of probation are met by the student.

Any punishment, suspension or expulsion may be set aside by the person having authority to impose same, and the student involved may be placed on probation for a fixed period of time. Said punishment, suspension or expulsion shall remain suspended so long as the conditions of probation are met by the student. Any student placed on probation shall be given a written list of the terms and conditions of his/her probation. He/she shall have such terms and conditions explained to him/her by the person granting such probation and the student shall sign a statement to the effect that he/she has had said terms and conditions fully explained by the person granting such probation, that he/she understands them and that he/she is willing to abide by them and that if he/she fails to do so, the punishment originally imposed may be reinstated at the discretion of the person granting such probation.
