- 1). All students exhibiting blood spills shall be taken to see the school nurse as soon as a teacher or staff member realizes that one of the students has been hurt, stabbed or wounded.
- 2). If the school nurse is not in the building, students will be brought to the principal's office and their parent or guardian will be notified to see if said parent or guardian wants the student to see a doctor.
- 3). Other students, present when the first student was injured, shall remain in the classroom until the teacher or nurse has determined if they have come in contact with the injured student's blood.
- 4). The administration shall develop a bloodborne pathogens exposure control plan in accordance with OSHA Standard 29 CFR 1910.1030.

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
