

Fees and Charges

Building principals or designated representatives shall be authorized to collect fees authorized by the board.

Fines

No fines shall be imposed upon any student provided, however, that school property lost, damaged or destroyed by a student shall be paid for by such student in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the board. Library fines may be imposed.

Fees and Charges

At the time of enrollment of classes at the beginning of each school year, the superintendent will distribute to all building principals and other school personnel designated by him/her as being authorized to charge and collect certain fees, a detailed list of all items for which a charge is to be collected, the amount of such charge, the date due, those exempt from the fee of charge and a system for collecting and accounting for such fees.

Fines

Building principals shall make a reasonable effort to collect the justifiable value of school property willfully or recklessly lost, damaged or destroyed by a student. If, after a reasonable amount of time, such amount remains unpaid, the principal shall report the matter to the superintendent who shall consult with the school board's attorney and they shall jointly recommend a course of action to the board.

When it is necessary for a student to permanently withdraw from classes in USD 273, the following procedure for refunding a portion of his/her original enrollment fees shall be used. The gross cost of all consumable materials (workbooks, etc.) and organizational dues shall be deducted from the original charges, with the balance being multiplied by the following percentages to arrive at the total refund to be made at the time of withdrawal.

Withdrawal during the first nine-weeks	75% of net
Withdrawal during the second nine-weeks	50% of net
Withdrawal during the third nine-weeks	25% of net

No refund shall be made to the student during the fourth nine-weeks.

Whenever a student enrolls after the beginning of the regular school year, the full gross cost of all consumable materials and organizational dues shall be charged plus a percentage of the remaining fees. Those percentages are as follows:

Enrollment during the first nine-weeks	100%
Enrollment during the second nine-weeks	75%
Enrollment during the third nine-weeks	50%
Enrollment during the fourth nine-weeks	25%
