The superintendent reported on: Legislative Update; Handed out a preliminary list of 2019 Summer Purchases and also handed out a Memorandum of Agreement from the City for baseball and softball field maintenance.

Kevin Ward from the Trane Corporation, was in attendance and presented a power point presentation on the HVAC project at the Beloit Elementary and Beloit Jr.-Sr. High School. His presentation consisted of data that was gathered from both buildings over certain time periods. To bring the current systems up to date, the cost would be around \$460,000. Randy Jamison and Dan Whistler were on the phone to help answer questions. The board instructed Mr. Travis to look at financing the project and looking to see what the enhancements for making the systems better will cost.

A motion was made by Ludwig, seconded by Budke, to approve assistant coaches for the spring sports. With this motion the following were approved: Marty Hesting, Assistant Baseball; Kiley Stutzman, Assistant Softball and Cade Hewitt, Assistant Track. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 0 Nays.

Odle moved that the Board of Education go into executive session at 8:10 P.M. for the purpose of discussing personnel matters on non-elected personnel and their contractual obligations because if this matter were discussed in open session it might invade the privacy of those discussed and that the Board of Education reconvene into open session at 8:20 P.M. in this room with Mr. Travis, Mr. Seyfert and Mr. Beisner remaining. The motion was seconded by Budke. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 0 Nays.
