The Cunningham Cable Request was tabled.

property, with Mr. Travis, Mr. Dean, Mr. Seyfert and Mr. Johnson remaining for the session. The motion was seconded by Budke. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 0 Nays.

The meeting reconvened into open session at 8:00 p.m.

Odle moved that the Board of Education go into executive session for ten (10) minutes from 8:00 p.m. until 8:10 p.m., for the purpose of preliminary discussion relating to acquisition of real property, with Mr. Travis, Mr. Dean, Mr. Seyfert and Mr. Johnson remaining for the session. The motion was seconded by Budke. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 0 Nays.

The meeting reconvened into open session at 8:10 p.m.

A motion was made by Budke, seconded by File, to pursue a lease purchase on Phase I of the Beloit Elementary School HVAC project and Phase I of the Beloit Jr-Sr High School HVAC project and to consolidate current lease purchases into one lease purchase. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 0 Nays.
