Building, MCPC & MCELC buildings). In taking on more property it would mean more mowing, snow removal, etc. Superintendent would like to pursue someone to take over grounds and handyman work in the evenings. It was the consensus of the board to have the superintendent pursue someone for this job. Other items were: Tuck point and clean entire stadium, have a bid for \$8,716.00 and they can start in two weeks; KASB regional meeting will be held Wednesday, October 2 at NCKTC from 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.; Booster Club Fundraising for a new press box at the stadium to be done in 2020-2021.

A motion was made by Ludwig, seconded by Budke, to approve the Site Council Appointments as presented by administration. (Lists attached) Motion carried: 6 Yeas, 0 Nays.

Janet Porter gave the PTO Report.

Trase McQueen gave the Student Council Report.

Chrissie Harris gave the BES Site Council Report.

Amber Krier expressed interest in the open USD 273 Board of Education position that was vacated by Mike Riemann. The board interviewed and asked Amber why she was interested in the position and to give a little bit of history about herself. She stated that she is originally from Tipton and is married to Scott Krier and they have three children, ages 9, 6 & 3. She is the Physical Therapy

Director at MCHHS for eleven years. Her interest is to focus on kids and wants to be involved in the district and know what is going on.

A motion was made by File, seconded by Budke, to appoint Amber Krier to the vacated position of Mike Riemann for the remainder of Mike's term. Motion carried: 6 Yeas, 0 Nays.

Immediately following the appointment, Amber Krier signed a Loyalty Oath that was administered by Doris Gasper, Clerk of the Board.

A motion was made by Budke, seconded by Ludwig, to allow the Clerk to publish property tax rates notice for 2019-2020. Motion carried: 7 Yeas, 0 Nays.

Mr. Johnson excused himself from the board meeting.

A motion was made by Budke, seconded by Ludwig, to renegotiate a lease purchase with Ameresco Project, BES New Addition Project and the TRANE Phase I project at Beloit Jr.-Sr. High School and to allow Jim Johnson, Board Attorney, to draw up a lease purchase agreement in the amount of \$195,792.47. Motion carried: 6 Yeas, 0 Nays.

Mr. Johnson returned to the meeting.

A motion was made by Ludwig, seconded by Salcido, to approve a new Jr. High School Volleyball Fundraising Activity Account. Motion carried: 7 Yeas, 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Krier, seconded by File, to approve a contract with Dr. Katrina Ostmeyer, Beyond the Individual Consultant and Registered Behavior Training for the 2019-2020 school year as presented by Mrs. Niemczyk. Motion carried: 7 Yeas, 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Odle, seconded by Budke, to allow the Superintendent and Board Attorney to approve a lease agreement request from Cunningham Cable. Motion carried: 7 Yeas, 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Odle, seconded by Budke, to appoint Joe File as the KASB Delegate Assembly Delegate for the annual convention in Wichita in December. Motion carried: 7 Yeas, 0 Nays.
