

## Definitions:

- **Close Contact:** An individual within 6 ft for at least 10-15 minutes of a person positive for COVID-19.
- **Quarantine:** For people identified as a close contact that were exposed to COVID-19, but not currently having any symptoms and not fully vaccinated for COVID-19.
- **Isolation:** For people who are currently infected or sick with COVID-19.
- If you or your student falls into one of these categories, you will be notified how long the isolation or quarantine period is.
- \* The health dept. is only able to identify close contacts based upon info. provided.

General CDC & KDHE Recommendations:

- Highly recommend masks to be worn by all individuals ages 2 and older indoors.
- Maintain physical distance of at least 3 feet between students when possible.
- Stay home and avoid contact with others if there are any signs of illness; Contact physician regarding testing.
- Handwashing with soap and water often.
- Receive a COVID-19 vaccine if eligible.

## Vaccinations, Mask Usage, and Quarantines

- Current COVID-19 vaccines:
- $\Rightarrow$  Moderna: 2 doses, 18 years and older
- $\Rightarrow$  J&J: 1 dose, 18 years and older
- $\Rightarrow$  Pfizer: 2 doses, 12 years and older
- Fully vaccinated people are not expected to quarantine after exposure if they meet the following criteria:
- ⇒ It is ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of 2nd dose in a 2-dose series, or 1st dose in a single dose series.
- $\Rightarrow$  Remain asymptomatic after exposure.
- Vaccines available at the HD and S&S Pharmacy.
- If <u>BOTH</u> the individual who tested positive <u>AND</u> the close contact are wearing a mask, the close contacts will not be expected to quarantine, as long as they remain asymptomatic.
- Information subject to change based upon CDC and KDHE updates.
