

The scholarship fund was administered by Trustees, Mike Haddock and Harry Gantenbein. In February 2017, the scholarship fund was turned over to the USD273 Endowment Association. Scholarships are awarded to high school graduates and students enrolled at a four-year institution and to students enrolled at a one or two-year institution of higher learning beyond the 12th grade level. No awards work beyond the Bachelor's degree level. Applicants must be residents of Mitchell County or have graduated from a Mitchell County high school.

After official verification from the Registrar's office of the student's enrollment, scholarship awards will be distributed through the students' college or university Financial Aid Office at the beginning of the first semester. Any scholarship \$1,000 or more will be split between the two semesters. The student has to submit official verification from the Registrar's office, one for each semester.

All applications are available on the USD 273 website and must be submitted online to the USD 273 Endowment Association **no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday, June 3, 2024** in order to be considered for the awards.

2. Explain your specific need for the scholarship.
3. Describe how you plan to use the scholarship funds. (Include the school you are enrolled in for next year.)
4. Describe your goals for completing your education.
5. Describe your career goals and objectives.
6. Include your school and community activities, work experience and GPA (Do not attach a resume. Included all information on this one page, please.)

Your name or reference to family is only on the cover sheet.

Include your official, complete transcript from the high school or university you attended this past year.

When this form is completed, the applicant must submit their application on or before 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 3, 2024.
